**Memorial of Gregory the Great** – September 3, 2008 – St. Gregory, senator and prefect of Rome, then in succession monk, cardinal and pope, governed the Church from 590 to 604. England owes her conversion to him. To him the liturgy owes several of its finest prayers, and the name "Gregorian chant" recalls this great Pope's work in the development of the Church's chant. Together with St. Ambrose, St. Augustine and St. Jerome, he is one of the four great Doctors of the Latin Church.

**Feast of the Nativity of Mary** – September 8, 2008 – Mary was born to be the mother of the Savior of the world, the spiritual mother of all men, and the holiest of God's creatures. She was conceived and born immaculate and full of grace. This is one of the three birthdays in the Church Calendar — the Birth of Jesus (December 25), the Birth of John the Baptist (June 24) and the Birthday of Mary. All three were born without original sin, although Mary and Jesus were conceived without sin, and St. John was cleansed of original sin while in the womb at the Visitation of Mary.

**Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross** – September 14, 2008 – This feast was celebrated originally to honor the anniversary of the discovery of the Holy Cross by St. Helena and the dedication of the basilicas consecrated at Jerusalem on September 14, 335, on the very site of the Holy Sepulchre and of Calvary.
